## A BILL

To impose a two year moratorium on the approval by the Secretary of the Interior of new Tribal-State compacts for gaming under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act.

3 **SECTION 1. TWO YEAR MORATORIUM ON NEW INDIAN CASI-**  
4 **NOS.**

5 The Secretary of the Interior shall not approve any  
6 new Tribal-State compacts for gaming under the Indian  
7 Gaming Regulatory Act (25 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.) until

1 after the date that is 2 years after the date of the enact-  
2 ment of this Act.
