2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. THREE-MONTH EXTENSION OF THE 2006 OPEN**  
4                       **ENROLLMENT PERIOD FOR MEDICARE PRE-**  
5                       **SCRIPTION DRUG PLANS.**

6       Section 1860D–1(b)(1)(B)(iii) of the Social Security  
7       Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–101(b)(1)(B)(iii)) is amended by

1 inserting “, except that in applying paragraph (1) of such  
2 section, with respect to the annual coordinated election pe-  
3 riod for 2006, such period shall continue through August  
4 15, 2006” before the period.
