- 7 Reconciliation Act of 2005, is amended by striking "estab-
- 8 lished by a State or local educational agency and recog-
- 9 nized as such by the Secretary" each place it appears in

- 1 subparagraphs (A)(i) and (B)(i) and inserting "recognized
- 2 as such by the chief State school officer of the State within

3 which such secondary school is located".
