10	(2) in subsection $(e)(2)$ —
11	(A) by striking "over mass" and inserting
12	the following: "over—
13	"(A) mass"; and
14	(B) by striking the period at the end and
15	inserting the following: "; or
16	"(B) the processing or sorting of solid
17	waste"
