1	SECTION 1. CONSISTENT COST-SHARING REQUIREMENTS
2	UNDER EMERGENCY WATERSHED PROTEC-
3	TION PROGRAM.
4	Section 102 of title I of division B of Public Law
5	109–148 (119 Stat. 2748) is amended—
6	(1) by redesignating subsections (c) and (d) as
7	subsections (d) and (e), respectively; and
8	(2) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
9	lowing new subsection (c):
10	"(c) Waiver or Reduction of Cost-Share Re-
11	QUIREMENT.—The Secretary of Agriculture may waive or
12	reduce the non-Federal cost share requirement imposed by
13	subsection (b) in cases in which the Secretary determines
14	that immediate action is or was required for environmental
15	or safety concerns and the local partner cannot or could
16	not financially participate.".
