## A BILL

To provide for the transfer of the U.S.S. IOWA to the  
Port of Stockton, California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF U.S.S. IOWA.**

4 (a) WAIVER OF REQUIREMENT FOR CONTINUED  
5 LISTING ON NAVAL VESSEL REGISTER.—The provisions  
6 of the following laws do not apply with respect to the  
7 U.S.S. IOWA (BB–61):

8 (1) Section 1011 of the National Defense Au-  
9 thorization Act for Fiscal Year 1996 (Public Law  
10 104–106; 110 Stat. 421).

1           (2) Section 1011 of the Strom Thurmond Na-  
2           tional Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year  
3           1999 (Public Law 105–261; 112 Stat. 2118).

4           (b) TRANSFER.—The Secretary of the Navy shall—

5           (1) strike the U.S.S. IOWA (BB–61) from the  
6           Naval Vessel Register; and

7           (2) subject to the submission of a donation ap-  
8           plication for that vessel that is satisfactory to the  
9           Secretary, transfer that vessel to the Port of Stock-  
10          ton, California, subject to subsections (b) and (c) of  
11          section 7306 of title 10, United States Code.
