## A BILL

To prevent acid mine drainage from sulfide mining into the Great Lakes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to protect water quality
- 5 in the Great Lakes from the harmful effects of acid mine
- 6 drainage.
- 7 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FEDERAL PERMITS.
- 8 No Federal permit may be issued to an entity seeking
- 9 to operate a sulfide mine within 5 miles of any of the
- 10 Great Lakes unless the permit applicant demonstrates
- 11 that there will be no acid mine drainage into any of the

- 1 Great Lakes as a result of the sulfide mining operation
- 2 for which the permit is sought.
- 3 SEC. 3. GREAT LAKES DEFINED.
- 4 In this Act, the term "Great Lakes" has the same
- 5 meaning given that term in section 118(a)(3) of the Fed-
- 6 eral Water Pollution Contol Act (33 U.S.C. 1268(a)(3)).
