## A BILL

To authorize the National War Dogs Monument, Inc. to establish a national monument in honor of military working dog teams.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. NATIONAL MILITARY WORKING DOG TEAMS**  
4               **MONUMENT.**

5       (a) AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MONUMENT.—The  
6       National War Dogs Monument, Inc. is authorized to es-  
7       tablish in the District of Columbia, a monument to honor  
8       the sacrifice and service of United States Armed Forces  
9       working dog teams that participate in the military endeav-  
10      ors of the United States.

1       (b) LOCATION.—The monument shall be located  
2 within the area that is referred to as Area II in section  
3 8908 of title 40, United States Code.

4       (c) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-  
5 RATIVE WORKS ACT.—The establishment of the monu-  
6 ment shall be in accordance with chapter 89 of title 40,  
7 United States Code, except as provided in subsection (b).

8       (d) LIMITATION ON PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.—The  
9 United States Government shall not pay any expense for  
10 the establishment or maintenance of the monument.
