A BILL

To pay a one-time bonus to members of the Armed Forces who serve honorably in a combat zone designated for Operation Iraqi Freedom or Operation Enduring Freedom, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. ONE-TIME BONUS FOR SERVICE IN COMBAT**
2 **ZONE DESIGNATED FOR OPERATION IRAQI**
3 **FREEDOM OR OPERATION ENDURING FREE-**
4 **DOM.**

5 (a) **MILITARY SERVICES.**—The Secretary of Defense
6 shall pay a one-time bonus of \$1,500 to each member of
7 the Army, Navy, Air Force, or Marine Corps, including
8 reserve components thereof, who served or serves for any
9 period of time in a combat zone designated in connection
10 with Operation Iraqi Freedom or Operation Enduring
11 Freedom, and whose service is characterized as honorable
12 by the Secretary.

13 (b) **COAST GUARD.**—The Secretary of Homeland Se-
14 curity shall pay a one-time bonus of \$1,500 to each mem-
15 ber of the Coast Guard or Coast Guard Reserve who
16 served or serves for any period of time in a combat zone
17 designated in connection with Operation Iraqi Freedom or
18 Operation Enduring Freedom, and whose service is char-
19 acterized as honorable by the Secretary.
