1	SECTION 1. ONE-TIME BONUS FOR SERVICE IN COMBAT

5	(a) Military Services.—The Secretary of Defense
6	shall pay a one-time bonus of \$1,500 to each member of
7	the Army, Navy, Air Force, or Marine Corps, including
8	reserve components thereof, who served or serves for any
9	period of time in a combat zone designated in connection
10	with Operation Iraqi Freedom or Operation Enduring
11	Freedom, and whose service is characterized as honorable
12	by the Secretary.
13	(b) Coast Guard.—The Secretary of Homeland Se-
14	curity shall pay a one-time bonus of \$1,500 to each mem-
15	ber of the Coast Guard or Coast Guard Reserve who
16	served or serves for any period of time in a combat zone
17	designated in connection with Operation Iraqi Freedom or
18	Operation Enduring Freedom, and whose service is char-
19	acterized as honorable by the Secretary
