- 7 tions for certain insurance programs) is amended—
- 8 (1) by striking "or" after "Corporation,", and

- 1 (2) by inserting at the end the following: "or
- 2 the Federal home loan banks,".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 4 subsection (a) shall apply to bonds issued after the date

5 of the enactment of this Act.
