A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to ensure adequate payment amounts for drugs and biologicals under part B of the Medicare Program.

- 3 SECTION 1. REVISION OF PAYMENT METHODOLOGY FOR
- 4 DRUGS AND BIOLOGICALS UNDER MEDICARE
- 5 PART B.
- 6 (a) Floor of Widely Available Market
- 7 Price.—Subsection (b) of section 1847A of the Social Se-
- 8 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–3a) is amended—

1	(1) in paragraph (1), by inserting "paragraph
2	(6) and" after "Subject to"; and
3	(2) by adding at the end the following new
4	paragraph:
5	"(6) Floor of widely available market
6	PRICE.—The Secretary shall increase the payment
7	amount determined under this subsection for a drug
8	or biological to the extent necessary to ensure that
9	such payment amount is in no case less than the
10	widely available market price for the drug or biologi-
11	cal (as determined under subsection (d) or by the
12	Secretary).".
13	(b) Treatment of Prompt Pay Discounts.—Sub-
14	section (c)(3) of such section is amended—
15	(1) in the first sentence, by inserting "fur-
16	nished to physicians" after "prompt pay discounts"
17	and
18	(2) in the second sentence, by inserting "(other
19	than prompt pay discounts)" after "other price con-
20	cessions".
21	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
22	this section shall apply to drugs and biologicals that are
23	furnished on or after January 1, 2007.
