- 5 ments under section 620K of the Foreign Assistance Act
- 6 of 1961 (as added by subsection (a) of this section) apply
- 7 with respect to the provision of assistance to nongovern-
- 8 mental organizations and voluntary and assessed contribu-
- 9 tions to international organizations for fiscal year 2007
- 10 and subsequent fiscal years.

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
