Mr. BRADLEY of New Hampshire introduced the following bill; which was  
referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

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## A BILL

To remove the permanent tariff and the temporary duty  
on ethanol.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Ethanol Import Fair-  
5       ness Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF ETHANOL TARIFF AND DUTY.**

7       (a) ELIMINATION OF PERMANENT TARIFF OF 2.5  
8       PERCENT.—Subheading 2207.10.60 of the Harmonized  
9       Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended—

10               (1) by striking the column 1 general rate of  
11       duty and inserting “Free”; and

1           (2) by striking the matter contained in the col-  
2       umn 1 special rate of duty column and inserting  
3       “Free”.

4       (b) REPEAL OF TEMPORARY DUTY OF 54 CENTS  
5       PER GALLON.—Subchapter I of chapter 99 of the Har-  
6       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amend-  
7       ed—

8           (1) by striking heading 9901.00.50; and

9           (2) by striking U.S. Note 2.

10       (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
11       this section apply with respect to goods entered, or with-  
12       drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the  
13       15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
