## A BILL

To amend the Florida National Forest Land Management Act of 2003 to authorize the conveyance of an additional tract of National Forest System land under that Act, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCES UNDER FLORIDA NATIONAL**  
4       **FOREST LAND MANAGEMENT ACT OF 2003.**

5       (a) ADDITIONAL CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—Sub-  
6       section (b) of section 3 of the Florida National Forest  
7       Land Management Act of 2003 (Public Law 108–152;  
8       117 Stat. 1919) is amended—

1           (1) by striking “and” at the end of paragraph  
2       (17);

3           (2) by redesignating paragraph (18) as para-  
4       graph (19);

5           (3) by inserting after paragraph (17) the fol-  
6       lowing new paragraph:

7           “(18) tract W-1979, located in Leon County  
8       consisting of approximately 114 acres, within T. 1  
9       S., R. 1 W., sec.25; and”; and

10          (4) in paragraph (19), as so redesignated, by  
11       striking “(17)” and inserting “(18)”.

12       (b) USE OF PROCEEDS.—Subsection (i)(2) of such  
13       section (117 Stat. 1921) is amended—

14          (1) by striking “and” at the end of subpara-  
15       graph (A);

16          (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-  
17       paragraph (B) and inserting “; and”; and

18          (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
19       paragraph:

20               “(C) acquisition, construction, or mainte-  
21       nance of administrative improvements for units  
22       of the National Forest System in the State.”.
