A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to improve and expand education savings accounts.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "401Kids Family Sav-

5 ings Act of 2006".

6 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DATE FOR SUNSET OF CERTAIN 7 EDUCATION SAVINGS INCENTIVES.

8 In the case of the provisions of, and amendments 9 made by, subtitle A of title IV of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 (relating to
 education savings incentives), section 901 of such Act (re lating to sunset of provisions of Act) shall be applied by
 substituting "December 31, 2015" for "December 31,
 2010" in subsection (a)(1) thereof.

6 SEC. 3. DISTRIBUTIONS FROM EDUCATION SAVINGS AC7 COUNTS FOR FIRST HOME PURCHASES 8 TREATED AS QUALIFIED DISTRIBUTIONS.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsections (b)(1), (d)(2)(A),
10 (d)(2)(B), (d)(2)(C)(ii)(II), and (d)(2)(D) of section 530
11 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 are each amended
12 by striking "qualified education expenses" and inserting
13 "qualified expenses".

14 (b) QUALIFIED EXPENSES.—Subsection (b) of sec-15 tion 530 of such Code is amended—

16 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (2) through
17 (4) as paragraphs (3) through (5), respectively, and
18 by inserting after paragraph (1) the following new
19 paragraph:

20 "(2) QUALIFIED EXPENSES.—The term 'quali21 fied expenses' means—

22 "(A) qualified education expenses (as de-23 fined in paragraph (3)), and

24 "(B) qualified first-time homebuyer expenses (as defined in paragraph (4)).", and

(2) by redesignating paragraphs (4) and (5) (as
 redesignated by paragraph (1)) as paragraphs (5)
 and (6), respectively, and by inserting after para graph (3) the following new paragraph:

"(4) QUALIFIED FIRST-TIME HOMEBUYER EX-5 6 PENSES.—The term 'qualified first-time homebuyer 7 expenses' means, in the case of a designated bene-8 ficiary who is a first-time homebuyer, the qualified 9 acquisition costs with respect to a principal resi-10 dence of such beneficiary. Terms used in this para-11 graph shall have the same meaning as when used in 12 section 72(t)(8).".

(c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The heading for
paragraph (2) of section 530(d) of such Code is amended
by striking "QUALIFIED EDUCATION EXPENSES" and inserting "QUALIFIED EXPENSES".

17 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by18 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after19 the date of the enactment of this Act.

20 SEC. 4. ROLLOVERS FROM EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNTS
21 TO ROTH IRAS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (5) of section 530(d)
of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended by section 5, is amended by inserting "or a Roth IRA" after
"another 401Kids savings account".

(b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Subsection (e) of
 section 408A of such Code is amended by inserting the
 following after the second sentence: "Such term includes
 a rollover contribution to a Roth IRA from a 401Kids sav ings account described in section 530(d)(5).".

6 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
7 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act.

9 SEC. 5. RENAMING COVERDELL EDUCATION SAVINGS AC10 COUNTS AS 401KIDS SAVINGS ACCOUNTS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 530 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking "Coverdell education savings account" each place it appears and inserting "401Kids savings account".
