To authorize the Secretary of the Army to acquire land for expansion of Pinon Canyon Maneuver Site, subject to certain conditions.

- 3 SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE LAND FOR EXPAN-
- 4 SION OF PINON CANYON MANEUVER SITE.
- 5 (a) AUTHORITY.—The Secretary of the Army may,
- 6 subject to subsections (b) and (c), after consulting with
- 7 the congressional defense committees, and using funds
- 8 previously appropriated for such purpose, acquire for not
- 9 more than fair market value any and all right, title, and
- 10 interest in and to one or more parcels of real property

- located near Pinon Canyon Maneuver Site (in this section referred to as the "Site") for the purpose of expanding 3 the Site. 4 (b) LIMITATION ON EXPANSION.—The Secretary of the Army may not acquire real property under subsection (a) to expand the Site if such acquisition would require the condemnation of such property, the seizure by a Fed-8 eral entity of any private property, or the exercise by a Federal or State governmental entity of eminent domain 10 authority. 11 (c) STUDY REQUIRED.—The Secretary of the Army 12 may not acquire real property under subsection (a) until 13 the Secretary has submitted to the congressional defense committees a study on— 14 15 (1) the economic impact on local communities 16 of such acquisition; 17 (2) the environmental impact of expanding the 18 Site pursuant to subsection (a); and 19 (3) the costs associated with potential environ-20 mental restoration, waste management, and other

24 (1) The term "congressional defense commit-25 tees" means the Committee on Armed Services and

the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate and the Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives.

(2) The term "fair market value" means, with respect to a parcel of land, the value of such parcel as determined by an appraisal performed by an independent, certified appraiser in accordance with the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice.
