Mr. DINGELL introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Vernadette Bader.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT BY THE SECRETARY OF THE TREAS-**
4 **URY.**

5 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay to
6 Vernadette Bader, of Taylor, Michigan, out of any
7 amounts in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the
8 sum of \$11,202.68, as compensation for an erroneous cal-
9 culation made by the National Labor Relations Board in
10 the distribution of funds from an employment discrimina-
11 tion settlement between Taylor Machine Products, Incor-

1 porated, and 7 former employees of that corporation, in-
2 cluding Vernadette Bader.

3 **SEC. 2. SATISFACTION OF CLAIMS.**

4 The payment made pursuant to section 1 shall be in
5 full satisfaction of all claims Vernadette Bader may have
6 against the United States for the economic injuries re-
7 ceived by her as a result of the erroneous calculation de-
8 scribed in section 1.

9 **SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY AND AGENT FEES.**

10 Not more than an amount equal to 10 percent of the
11 amount paid pursuant to section 1 may be paid to or re-
12 ceived by any attorney or agent for services rendered to
13 Vernadette Bader with respect to the compensation re-
14 ferred to in section 1. Any person who violates this section
15 shall be subject to a fine under title 18, United States
16 Code.
