A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to authorize appropriations for fiscal years 2005 through 2011 to carry out the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “State Criminal Alien
5 Assistance Program Reauthorization Act of 2005”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL**2 **YEARS 2005 THROUGH 2011.**

3 Section 241(i)(5) of the Immigration and Nationality
4 Act (8 U.S.C. 1231(i)(5)) is amended by striking “appro-
5 priated” and all that follows through the period and in-
6 serting the following:

7 “appropriated to carry out this subsection—

8 “(A) such sums as may be necessary for
9 fiscal year 2005;

10 “(B) \$750,000,000 for fiscal year 2006;

11 “(C) \$850,000,000 for fiscal year 2007;

12 and

13 “(D) \$950,000,000 for each of the fiscal
14 years 2008 through 2011.”.
