A BILL

To permit States to place supplemental guide signs relating to veterans cemeteries on Federal-aid highways.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HIGHWAY SIGNS RELATING TO VETERANS**

4 **CEMETERIES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the terms of any
6 agreement entered into by the Secretary of Transportation
7 and a State under section 109(d) or 402(a) of title 23,
8 United States Code, a veterans cemetery shall be treated
9 as a site for which a supplemental guide sign may be
10 placed on any Federal-aid highway.

1 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall apply to an
2 agreement entered into before, on, or after the date of en-
3 actment of this Act.
