A BILL

For the relief of Maria Cristina Degrassi.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR MARIA
- 4 CRISTINA DEGRASSI.
- 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
- 6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
- 7 Act, Maria Cristina Degrassi shall be eligible for issuance
- 8 of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that
- 9 of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence
- 10 upon filing an application for issuance of an immigrant
- 11 visa under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment of
- 12 status to lawful permanent resident.

- 1 (b) Adjustment of Status.—If Maria Cristina
- 2 Degrassi enters the United States before the filing dead-
- 3 line specified in subsection (c), the alien shall be consid-
- 4 ered to have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if
- 5 otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status
- 6 under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
- 7 as of the date of enactment of this Act.
- 8 (c) Deadline for Application and Payment of
- 9 Fees.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
- 10 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
- 11 tion for adjustment of status are filed with appropriate
- 12 fees within 2 years after the date of enactment of this
- 13 Act.
- 14 (d) Reduction of Immigrant Visa Numbers.—
- 15 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
- 16 idence to Maria Cristina Degrassi, the Secretary of State
- 17 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by the appro-
- 18 priate number, during the current or next following fiscal
- 19 year, the total number of immigrant visas that are made
- 20 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
- 21 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 22 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas
- 23 that are made available to natives of the country of the
- 24 aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.
