1SEC. 2. LIKENESS OF PRESIDENT REAGAN REQUIRED TO2BE INCLUDED ON THE FACE OF \$50 FEDERAL3RESERVE NOTES.

The 8th undesignated paragraph of section 16 of the
Federal Reserve Act (12 U.S.C. 418) is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence: "The face of
\$50 Federal reserve notes printed after December 31,
2005, shall bear the likeness of President Ronald Wilson
Reagan".
