A BILL

To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in the Inland Empire regional recycling project and in the Cucamonga Valley Water District recycling project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INLAND EMPIRE AND CUCAMONGA VALLEY RE-**
4 **CYCLING PROJECTS.**

5 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This section may be cited as the
6 “Inland Empire Regional Water Recycling Initiative”.

1 (b) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and
2 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (Public Law 102–
3 575, Title XVI; 43 U.S.C. 390h et seq.) is amended by
4 adding at the end the following:

5 **“SEC. 1637. INLAND EMPIRE REGIONAL WATER RECYCLING**
6 **PROJECT.**

7 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, in cooperation
8 with the Inland Empire Utilities Agency, may participate
9 in the design, planning, and construction of the Inland
10 Empire regional water recycling project described in the
11 report submitted under section 1606(c).

12 “(b) COST SHARING.—The Federal share of the cost
13 of the project described in subsection (a) shall not exceed
14 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

15 “(c) LIMITATION.—Funds provided by the Secretary
16 shall not be used for operation and maintenance of the
17 project described in subsection (a).

18 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
19 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
20 \$20,000,000.

21 **“SEC. 1638. CUCAMONGA VALLEY WATER RECYCLING**
22 **PROJECT.**

23 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, in cooperation
24 with the Cucamonga Valley Water District, may partici-
25 pate in the design, planning, and construction of the

1 Cucamonga Valley Water District satellite recycling plants
2 in Rancho Cucamonga, California, to reclaim and recycle
3 approximately 2 million gallons per day of domestic waste-
4 water.

5 “(b) COST SHARING.—The Federal share of the cost
6 of the project described in subsection (a) shall not exceed
7 25 percent of the capital cost of the project.

8 “(c) LIMITATION.—Funds provided by the Secretary
9 shall not be used for operation and maintenance of the
10 project described in subsection (a).

11 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
12 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section,
13 \$10,000,000.”.

14 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—The table of sec-
15 tions in section 2 of Public Law 102–575 is amended by
16 inserting after the item relating to section 1636 the fol-
17 lowing:

“1637. Inland Empire Regional Water Recycling Program.

“1638. Cucamonga Valley Water Recycling Project.”.
