A BILL

To redesignate the Rio Grande American Canal in El Paso,
Texas, as the “Travis C. Johnson Canal”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The canal located in El Paso, Texas, constructed as
5 part of the Rio Grande canalization project under the Act
6 entitled “An Act authorizing construction, operation, and
7 maintenance of Rio Grande canalization project and au-
8 thorizing appropriation for that purpose”, approved June
9 4, 1936 (49 Stat. 1463), and known as the “Rio Grande

1 American Canal” shall be redesignated and known as the
2 “Travis C. Johnson Canal”.

3 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

4 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
5 paper, or other record of the United States to the canal
6 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
7 to the “Travis C. Johnson Canal”.
