## A BILL

To require air carriers to honor tickets for bankrupt air service.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Airline Consumer Pro-
- 5 tection Act of 2005".
- 6 SEC. 2. AIR CARRIERS REQUIRED TO HONOR TICKETS FOR
- 7 SUSPENDED SERVICE.
- 8 (a) In General.—Each air carrier that provides
- 9 scheduled air transportation on a route shall provide, to
- 10 the extent practicable, air transportation to passengers
- 11 ticketed for air transportation on that route by any other

- 1 air carrier that suspends, interrupts, or discontinues air
- 2 passenger service on the route by reason of insolvency or
- 3 bankruptcy of the other air carrier.
- 4 (b) Passenger Obligation.—An air carrier is not
- 5 required to provide air transportation under subsection (a)
- 6 to a passenger unless that passenger makes alternative ar-
- 7 rangements with the air carrier for such transportation
- 8 within 60 days after the date on which that passenger's
- 9 air transportation was suspended, interrupted, or discon-
- 10 tinued (without regard to the originally scheduled travel
- 11 date on the ticket).

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
