To amend title 49, United States Code, to allow additional transit systems greater flexibility with certain mass transportation projects.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Transit System Flexi-
- 5 bility Protection Act of 2005".
- 6 SEC. 2. GENERAL AUTHORITY.
- 7 Section 5307(b)(1) of title 49, United States Code,
- 8 is amended by adding at the end the following: "The Sec-
- 9 retary may make grants under this section to a transit

- 1 system to finance the operating cost of equipment and fa-
- 2 cilities for use in mass transportation in an urbanized area
- 3 with a population of more than 200,000 if such transit
- 4 system operates less than 100 buses on fixed route service

5 during peak service hours.".
