A BILL

For the relief of Zdenko Lisak.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL OF, OR 4 DENIAL OF ADMISSION TO, ZDENKO LISAK. 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding sections 212(a) 6 and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Zdenko Lisak may not be removed from the United States, 8 or denied admission to the United States, by reason of any act of his that is a ground for removal or denial of 10 admission and is reflected in the records of the Immigration and Naturalization Service of the Department of Jus-

- 1 tice, or the Visa Office of the Department of State, on
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 3 (b) Rescission of Outstanding Order of Re-
- 4 MOVAL.—The Attorney General shall rescind any out-
- 5 standing order of removal or deportation, or any finding
- 6 of deportability, that has been entered against Zdenko
- 7 Lisak by reason of any act described in subsection (a).
