- 4 AS HIGH PRIORITY CORRIDOR ON NATIONAL
- 5 HIGHWAY SYSTEM.
- 6 Section 1105(c) of the Intermodal Surface Transpor-
- 7 tation Efficiency Act of 1991 (105 Stat. 2032; 112 Stat.
- 8 191; 118 Stat. 293) is amended by adding at the end the
- 9 following new paragraph:

1	"(46) The California Farm-to-Market Corridor.
2	California State Route 99 from south of Bakersfield
3	to Sacramento, California.".
4	SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF CALIFORNIA STATE ROUTE 99 AS
5	FUTURE ROUTE ON INTERSTATE SYSTEM.
6	Subject to the requirements of section 103(c)(4)(B)
7	of title 23, United States Code, the Secretary of Transpor-
8	tation shall designate California State Route 99 from
9	south of Bakersfield to Sacramento, California, as a fu-
10	ture route on the Interstate System.
