Mr. HOEKSTRA submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on House Administration

RESOLUTION

Providing amounts for the expenses of the Committee on
Intelligence in the One Hundred Ninth Congress.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.**

3 For the expenses of the Committee on Intelligence
4 (hereafter in this resolution referred to as the “Com-
5 mittee”), including the expenses of all staff salaries, there
6 shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House
7 of Representatives for committee salaries and expenses,
8 not more than \$9,875,428.82 for the One Hundred Ninth
9 Congress.

1 **SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.**

2 Of the amount specified in section 1—

3 (1) not more than \$4,438,939.16 shall be avail-
4 able for expenses incurred during the period begin-
5 ning at noon on January 3, 2005, and ending imme-
6 diately before noon on January 3, 2006; and

7 (2) not more than \$5,436,489.66 shall be avail-
8 able for expenses incurred during the period begin-
9 ning at noon on January 3, 2006, and ending imme-
10 diately before noon on January 3, 2007.

11 **SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.**

12 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
13 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
14 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
15 directed by the Committee on House Administration.

16 **SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.**

17 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
18 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
19 the Committee on House Administration.
