RESOLUTION

Increasing the amount provided for the Members' Representational Allowance of a Member of the House of Representatives who employs a veteran with a service-connected disability.

2 **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN MEMBERS' REPRESENTATIONAL**

3 **ALLOWANCE FOR MEMBERS HIRING DIS-**

4 **ABLED VETERANS.**

5 (a) INCREASE IN ALLOWANCE.—The amount other-

6 wise provided during a year for the Members' Representa-

7 tional Allowance of a Member of the House of Representa-

8 tives (including a Delegate or Resident Commissioner to

1 the Congress) shall be increased by \$50,000 if at any time
2 during the year a qualified disabled veteran is an employee
3 of the Member's office whose salary is paid from such Al-
4 lowance.

5 (b) QUALIFIED DISABLED VETERAN DEFINED.—In
6 this section, a “qualified disabled veteran” is an individual
7 who is a veteran with a service-connected disability (as
8 such terms are defined in section 101 of title 38, United
9 States Code) whose level of disability is not less than 30
10 percent, as certified by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.
