RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3763) to reinstate the application of the wage requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act to Federal contracts in areas affected by Hurricane Katrina.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution the House shall without intervention of any
3 point of order consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3763)
4 to reinstate the application of the wage requirements of
5 the Davis-Bacon Act to Federal contracts in areas affected
6 by Hurricane Katrina. The bill shall be considered as read.
7 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
8 the bill to final passage without intervening motion except:

- 1 (1) one hour of debate on the bill equally divided and con-
- 2 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
- 3 the Committee on Education and the Workforce; and (2)
- 4 one motion to recommit.
