## **RESOLUTION**

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 55) requiring the President to develop and implement a plan for the withdrawal of United States Armed Forces from Iraq.

- 1 Resolved, That immediately after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
- 3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
- 4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
- 5 ation of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 55) requiring the
- 6 President to develop and implement a plan for the with-
- 7 drawal of United States Armed Forces from Iraq. All
- 8 points of order against consideration of the joint resolu-

- 1 tion are waived. After a first reading of the joint resolu-
- 2 tion, general debate shall be confined to the joint resolu-
- 3 tion and shall not exceed 17 hours equally divided and
- 4 controlled by the majority leader and minority leader or
- 5 their designees. After general debate the joint resolution
- 6 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute
- 7 rule. The joint resolution shall be considered as read. At
- 8 the conclusion of consideration of the joint resolution for
- 9 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the joint
- 10 resolution to the House with such amendments as may
- 11 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
- 12 ered as ordered on the joint resolution and amendments
- 13 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
- 14 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
- 15 Sec. 2. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-
- 16 ports that it has come to no resolution on the joint resolu-
- 17 tion, then on the next legislative day the House shall, im-
- 18 mediately after the third daily order of business under
- 19 clause 1 of rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the
- 20 Whole for further consideration of the joint resolution.
