RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3936) to protect consumers from price-gouging of gasoline and other fuels during energy emergencies, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution the House shall without intervention of any
3 point of order consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3936)
4 to protect consumers from price-gouging of gasoline and
5 other fuels during energy emergencies, and for other pur-
6 poses. The bill shall be considered as read. The previous
7 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill to final
8 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour
9 of debate on the bill equally divided and controlled by the

- 1 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
- 2 on Energy and Commerce; and (2) one motion to recom-
- 3 mit.
