## RESOLUTION

2 resolution the House shall without intervention of any  
3 point of order consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3925)  
4 to provide that a Federal public safety position may not  
5 be held by any political appointee who does not meet cer-  
6 tain minimum requirements. The bill shall be considered  
7 as read. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
8 dered on the bill to final passage without intervening mo-

1 tion except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill equally di-  
2 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-  
3 ity member of the Committee on Government Reform; and  
4 (2) one motion to recommit.
