7 as read. The previous question shall be considered as or-
8 dered on the bill to final passage without intervening mo-

1 tion except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill equally di-
2 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
3 ity member of the Committee on Energy and Commerce;
4 and (2) one motion to recommit.
