- (1) the President is requested to transmit to the House of Representatives, not later than 14 days after the date of the adoption of this resolution, all documents, including telephone and electronic mail records, logs, calendars, minutes, and memos, in the possession of the President relating to—
 - (A) the scope of the activities undertaken by the Department of Defense, the Counterintelligence Field Activity, or any related agency with regard to Threat and Local Observation Notice reports (TALONs); and
 - (B) the legal authority upon which surveillance by the National Security Agency or the Department of Defense of persons inside the United States and the gathering of counterterrorism intelligence within the United States without obtaining court-ordered warrants is based; and

- 1 (2) the Secretary of Defense is directed to
 2 transmit to the House of Representatives, not later
 3 than 14 days after the date of the adoption of this
 4 resolution, all documents, including telephone and
 5 electronic mail records, logs, calendars, minutes,
 6 memos, and records of internal discussions, in the
 7 possession of the Secretary relating to—
 - (A) the scope of the activities undertaken by the Department of Defense, the Counterintelligence Field Activity, or any related agency with regard to Threat and Local Observation Notice reports; and
 - (B) the legal authority upon which surveillance by the National Security Agency or the Department of Defense of persons inside the United States and the gathering of counterterrorism intelligence within the United States without obtaining court-ordered warrants is based.
