## RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require preapproval of privately-funded travel and the inclusion of such travel information on the public website of the Office of the Clerk of the House of Representatives, and for other purposes.

- 2 SECTION 1. PREAPPROVAL AND POST-REVIEW OF PRI-
- 3 VATELY-FUNDED CONGRESSIONAL TRAVEL.
- 4 Clause 5 of rule XXV of the Rules of the House of
- 5 Representatives is amended by redesignating paragraphs
- 6 (e) and (f) as paragraphs (g) and (h), respectively, and

- 1 by inserting after paragraph (d) the following new para-
- 2 graphs:
- 3 "(e)(1) Before a Member, Delegate, Resident Com-
- 4 missioner, officer, or employee of the House may take a
- 5 privately-funded trip—
- 6 "(A) that individual shall provide to the Com-
- 7 mittee on Standards of Official Conduct the com-
- 8 plete itinerary and estimated expenses of the trip
- 9 and an explanation of the purpose of the trip and
- its relationship to their official duties; and
- 11 "(B) that committee shall make a determina-
- tion that the proposed trip (including the itinerary
- and estimated expenses) complies with all applicable
- rules of the House.
- 15 "(2)(A) Within 15 (not counting Saturdays, Sundays,
- 16 and holidays) days after completion of any trip described
- 17 in subparagraph (1), the Member, Delegate, Resident
- 18 Commissioner, officer, or employee of the House making
- 19 such trip shall provide the actual itinerary and actual ex-
- 20 penses to the Committee on Standards of Official Con-
- 21 duct.
- 22 "(B) Within 45 days after receipt of any information
- 23 received under subdivision (A), the Committee on Stand-
- 24 ards of Official Conduct shall verify compliance with the

- 1 itinerary and expenses it preapproved and send the results
- 2 of its review to the Clerk.".
- 3 SEC. 2. INTERNET POSTING OF INFORMATION SUBMITTED
- 4 ON PRIVATELY-FUNDED TRAVEL.
- 5 Clause 5(b)(5) of rule XXV of the Rules of the House
- 6 of Representatives is amended to read as follows:
- 7 "(5) Not later than 10 days after receipt, the Clerk
- 8 shall post on the public Internet site of the Office of the
- 9 Clerk any information submitted to the Clerk under this
- 10 clause with respect to a privately-funded trip, including
- 11 the advance authorizations and disclosures of reimburse-
- 12 ment filed under subparagraph (1) and the itinerary and
- 13 expenses sent to the Clerk by the Committee on Standards
- 14 of Official Conduct under paragraph (e)(2)(B). The infor-
- 15 mation shall remain available on the website until the indi-
- 16 vidual no longer serves as a Member, Delegate, Resident
- 17 Commissioner, officer, or employee of the House.".

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
