2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AIRLINE WAR RISK POLICIES**  
4       **AND TERRORISM COVERAGE.**

5       (a) EXTENSION OF POLICIES.—Section 44302(f) of  
6       title 49, United States Code, is amended by striking “Au-

1 gust 31, 2005, and shall extend through December 31,  
2 2005,” in paragraph (1) and inserting “August 31, 2008,  
3 and shall extend through December 31, 2008,”.

4 (b) EXTENSION OF TERRORISM COVERAGE.—Section  
5 44303(b) of title 49, United States Code, is amended by  
6 striking “December 31, 2005,” and inserting “December  
7 31, 2008,”.
