A BILL

To authorize the placement of a monument in Arlington National Cemetery honoring the veterans who fought in World War II as members of Army Ranger Battalions.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ARMY RANGER BATTALIONS MONUMENT IN AR-
- 4 LINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY.
- 5 Section 2409 of title 38, United States Code, is
- 6 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 7 "(c)(1) The Secretary of the Army is authorized to
- 8 place a monument in Arlington National Cemetery to

- 1 honor veterans who fought in World War II as members
- 2 of United States Army Ranger Battalions.
- 3 "(2) The Secretary of the Army shall have exclusive
- 4 authority to approve an appropriate design and an appro-
- 5 priate and accessible site within the Arlington National
- 6 Cemetery for the monument authorized under paragraph

7 (1).".
