A BILL

To amend the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 to provide for training service and delivery innovation projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRAINING SERVICE AND DELIVERY INNOVA-**
4 **TION PROJECTS.**

5 Section 171(b)(1)(D) of the Workforce Investment
6 Act of 1998 (29 U.S.C. 2916(b)(1)(D)) is amended to
7 read as follows:

8 “(D) targeted innovation projects that im-
9 prove access to and delivery of employment and
10 training services, with emphasis given to

1 projects that incorporate advanced technologies
2 to facilitate the connection of individuals to the
3 information and tools they need to upgrade
4 skills, including projects that link individuals in
5 need of training to opportunities for self-guided
6 learning, and with priority given to projects
7 that—

8 “(i) actively promote sources of infor-
9 mation about training opportunities and
10 training content by providing technology
11 directly to eligible training recipients;

12 “(ii) provide for the conduct of online
13 eligibility determinations for Federal and
14 State training programs, and direct indi-
15 viduals to the appropriate programs in the
16 area; and

17 “(iii) integrate high-quality employ-
18 ment and training services information
19 with the delivery of information regarding
20 other social services and health care pro-
21 grams;”.
