 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Spent Nuclear Fuel
 - 5 Tracking and Accountability Act".
 - 6 SEC. 2. SPENT FUEL RODS.
 - 7 (a) Guidelines.—Not later than 260 days after the
 - 8 date of enactment of this Act, the Nuclear Regulatory
 - 9 Commission shall establish—

1	(1) specific and uniform guidelines for tracking,
2	controlling, and accounting for individual spent fuel
3	rods or segments at nuclear power plants, including
4	procedures for conducting physical inventories; and
5	(2) uniform inspection procedures to verify any
6	action taken by a nuclear power plant to implement
7	those guidelines.
8	(b) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
9	of enactment of this Act, the Nuclear Regulatory Commis-
10	sion shall submit to Congress a report describing the
11	progress of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in estab-
12	lishing the guidelines under subsection (a).
