3 **SECTION 1. DALIP SINGH SAUND POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 30777 Rancho California Road

1 in Temecula, California, shall be known and designated
2 as the “Dalip Singh Saund Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Dalip Singh Saund
7 Post Office Building.
