1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF JOHN L. BURTON TRAIL.**

4 (a) **SHORT TITLE.**—This Act may be cited as the
5 “John L. Burton Trail Act”.

6 (b) **DESIGNATION OF JOHN L. BURTON TRAIL.**—Any
7 trail authorized by the final management plan under sec-
8 tion 501(i) of Public Law 105–33 (111 Stat. 1613) for
9 Headwaters Forest Reserve, California, that is con-
10 structed to provide access to the southern end of the

- 1 Headwaters Grove near the existing Salmon Trailhead
- 2 shall be known as the “John L. Burton Trail”.
