Mr. Johnson (for himself and Mr. Thune) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To facilitate the transfer of Spearfish Hydroelectric Plant Number 1 to the city of Spearfish, South Dakota, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. FINDINGS. 4 Congress finds that— 5 (1) Spearfish Hydroelectric Plant Number 1— 6 (A) operates under a right-of-way grant administered by the Forest Service; and 7 8 (B) is not subject to the jurisdiction of the 9 Federal Energy Regulatory Commission;

1	(2) the transfer of the Plant from the
2	Homestake Mining Company to the city of Spear-
3	fish, South Dakota—
4	(A) would maintain the historic benefits of
5	the Plant; and
6	(B) would not—
7	(i) affect the validity of the right-of-
8	way grant; or
9	(ii) subject the Plant to the jurisdic-
10	tion of the Commission; and
11	(3) it is in the public interest for the Plant to
12	continue to operate in a manner that protects and
13	improves—
14	(A) fish hatchery operations;
15	(B) recreation;
16	(C) historical interpretation;
17	(D) irrigation;
18	(E) hydroelectric power generation; and
19	(F) the aesthetic value of Spearfish City
20	Park.
21	SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
22	In this Act:
23	(1) Commission.—The term "Commission"
24	means the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

1	(2) PLANT.—The term "Plant" means the
2	Spearfish Hydroelectric Plant Number 1 that—
3	(A) is located in Lawrence County, South
4	Dakota;
5	(B) operates in accordance with a valid
6	right-of-way grant—
7	(i) issued by the General Land Office
8	of the Department of the Interior in 1909;
9	and
10	(ii) administered by the Forest Serv-
11	ice as of the date of enactment of this Act;
12	and
13	(C) is described in Commission docket
14	number UL00-3.
15	(3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
16	the Secretary of the Interior.
17	SEC. 3. EXEMPTION OF THE PLANT FROM COMMISSION JU-
18	RISDICTION.
19	Part I of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 791a
20	et seq.) shall not apply to the Plant until and unless other-
21	wise provided by Congress.
22	SEC. 4. STUDY OF SPEARFISH CREEK HYDROLOGY.
23	(a) In General.—The Secretary, acting through the
24	United States Geological Survey, shall carry out a study
25	of the hydrology of Spearfish Creek, South Dakota.

1	(b) Authorization of Appropriations.—There is
2	authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to carry
3	out the study under subsection (a) \$250,000 for each of
4	fiscal years 2006 through 2009.
5	SEC. 5. SENSE OF CONGRESS.
6	It is the sense of Congress that the city of Spearfish
7	South Dakota, to provide for the restoration and improve-
8	ment of Spearfish Creek, should—
9	(1) uphold the Memorandum Agreement of the
10	city of Spearfish and the Spearfish Canyon Land-
11	owners Association, dated September 14, 2004; and
12	(2) take action to release additional water flow
13	of approximately 5 to 10 cubic feet per second be-
14	tween the Maurice Intake Dam and the Spearfish
15	Diversion.

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
