2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON A CERTAIN CHEM-**
4 **ICAL.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following:

“	9902.39.14	Ion Exchange resin powder comprised of a copolymer of methacrylic acid cross-linked with divinylbenzene, in the hydrogen ionic form, dried to less than 5% moisture (CAS No. 50602–21–6)(provided for in sub-heading 3914.00.60)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2008	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
