A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on O-Chlorotoluene.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY OF O-CHLOROTOLUENE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new headings:

“	9902.39.16	2-Chlorotoluene (CAS No. 95–49–8) (provided for in subheading 2903.69.80)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009
	9902.39.17	Chloromethylbenzene (CAS No. 25168–05–2) (provided for in subheading 2903.69.80)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009

”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
