A BILL

For the relief of Ilko Vasilev Ivanov, Anelia Marinova Peneva, Marina Ilkova Ivanova, and Julia Ilkova Ivanova.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 In the administration of the Immigration and Nation-
- 5 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Ilko Vasilev Ivanov,
- 6 Anelia Marinova Peneva, Marina Ilkova Ivanova, and
- 7 Julia Ilkova Ivanova shall be held and considered to have
- 8 been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent
- 9 residence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon
- 10 payment of the required visa fees.

1 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

- 2 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Ilko
- 3 Vasilev Ivanov, Anelia Marinova Peneva, Marina Ilkova
- 4 Ivanova, and Julia Ilkova Ivanova as provided in this Act,
- 5 the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to
- 6 reduce by the appropriate number during the current fis-
- 7 cal year the total number of immigrant visas available to
- 8 natives of the country of the aliens' birth under subsection
- 9 (a) of section 203 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
- 10 (8 U.S.C. 1153).
