Ms. LANDRIEU introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of Gisele Goldberg Schexnider.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATURALIZATION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
5 sion of law or any order, Gisele Goldberg Schexnider shall  
6 be deemed to have complied with all the requirements of  
7 chapter 2 of title III of the Immigration and Nationality  
8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1421 et seq.) to become a naturalized citi-  
9 zen of the United States, including the residency require-  
10 ment under section 319 of such Act (8 U.S.C. 1430).

11 (b) OATH OF RENUNCIATION AND ALLEGIANCE.—  
12 The Secretary of Homeland Security shall schedule, as

1 soon as practicable, a public ceremony at which Gisele  
2 Goldberg Schexnider may take the oath of citizenship in  
3 accordance with section 337 of the Immigration and Na-  
4 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1448).

5 (c) CERTIFICATE OF NATURALIZATION.—After the  
6 oath is taken under subsection (b), the Secretary of Home-  
7 land Security shall provide Gisele Goldberg Schexnider  
8 with a certificate of naturalization in accordance with sec-  
9 tion 338 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
10 1449).
