- 5 Maine, authorized under section 107 of the River and
- 6 Harbor Act of 1960 (74 Stat. 486), and described as a
- 7 6-foot deep, 10-acre maneuvering basin located at the
- 8 head of navigation, is redesignated as an anchorage area.
