Mr. STEVENS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of Katarina Galovic Gnall.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-  
5       poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6       1101 et seq.), Katarina Galovic Gnall, the daughter of  
7       former Yugoslavian diplomats, shall be held and consid-  
8       ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States  
9       for permanent residence as of the date of the enactment  
10      of this Act upon payment of the required visa fee.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2       Upon the granting of permanent residence to  
3 Katarina Galovic Gnall as provided in this Act, the Sec-  
4 retary of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce  
5 by 1 during the current fiscal year the total number of  
6 immigrant visas available to natives of the country of the  
7 alien's birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration and  
8 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
